

Welcome to Hyuga Municipal Library!

First-time Users of the Library

You will need to submit an application form to the front desk to obtain a "Library Card". Anyone can obtain a "Library Card". If you are a junior high school student or younger, please use the pink form. Otherwise, please use the light blue form.

Borrowing Books

You may borrow up to 10 books for 15 days. Items labeled "館内" or "禁帯出" and latest editions of periodicals are not for loan. Please use these at the library. If no holds have been placed on your loaned item, you may renew it indefinitely.

Returning Books

Return books to the front desk. ("Library Card" is not necessary.)

When the library is closed, return your books using the slot beside the entrance labeled "返却ポスト".

Don't return books directly to the bookshelves.

Searching for Books

Library Computers can be used to search for books. If you need assistance, please ask our staff.

Placing Books on Hold,

Items on loan may be put on hold by submitting a reservation form to the front desk.

Holds made via internet or mobile phones require you to register your password.

Requesting Books

Requests are limited to those who live, work or study in Hyuga.

Submit a "Request" form to the front desk.

We may not be able to comply with every request.

Reference Service (Search Assistance)

If you're having trouble finding a book, please ask one of our staff.

If you have queries, questions, or would like us to search for an item, feel free to ask for assistance. (Please be aware that depending on the nature of your inquiry we may not be able to assist you.)

Hometown Resource Corner

We have resources regarding Miyazaki

Prefecture and Hyuga City. If you have any questions, please ask our staff.

Use of these resources is limited to the library.

If you would like to use the "Hometown Resource" room please ask the front desk.

Newspapers & Periodicals

Current newspapers are in the reading room on the second floor.

Ask our staff about past newspapers issues.

Latest issues of periodicals are not for loan.

Copy Service

Only library resources may be copied within the limits of copyright.

(Monochrome: ¥20/sheet Polychrome: ¥100/sheet)

We lend books to schools and reading groups for extended periods of time.




